Re: Executive Order issued March 26, 2025 Adjusting Imports of Automobiles and Automobile Parts into the United States

To our valued partners and clients,

On March 26, POTUS held a press conference stating additional tariffs of 25% on all automobiles imported into the United States of manufacturing origin outside the United States of America. This will become effective 12:01am ET April 3, 2025.

There will be a similar tariff of 25% for all automobile parts manufactured outside of the US and imported no later than May 3, 2025. This date may be adjusted as determined by future publication in the Federal Register.

Current publications indicate the 25% tariffs will be stacked on top of current 2.5% tariffs.

The only exception from the additional tariffs are for vehicles and vehicle parts that qualify for preferential tariff treatment under USMCA. To qualify, documentation reporting the amount of US content is required and the tariff will remain in effect with the value of non-US content.
